THE FUTURE OF THE CPO

Since I last reported in the April 2016 VPI there has been a great deal of work going on "behind the scenes" regarding this subject.

The latest news is that on 8th December 2016 the CPO had received a letter from the Ville de Lausanne stating that the Municipalité have agreed to grant an extension of the right of usage of the land (droit de superficie) for a period of **three years**. All current conditions of the right of usage will remain unchanged until 5th December 2020.

The letter also states that this extension period should permit feasibility studies to be made regarding the total use of the plot 5545 i.e. renovation of the CPO, renovation of the church, school construction etc. This extension will require a legal change to the "droit de superficie" and the Ville de Lausanne will cover the legal costs involved.

On the 19th December 2016, Timothée Deblock, Président Association CPO and **Véronique Biollay-Kennedy**, **Directrice CPO** had a meeting to discuss the details of the extension of the "droit de superficie" with:

- M. David Payot, Conseiller municipal, Directeur de l'enfance, jeunesse et quartiers and:
- Mme. Estelle Papaux, Cheffe de Service de la jeunesse et des loisirs.

At the time of going to press of this VPI, the results of this meeting are not known to me but I will be able to keep you up to date with the progress by participation on the CPO Comité. Colin Gamage.

Dear Friends

Greetings from England.

Yes, England. After 36 years, I returned to my birthplace. I left Switzerland on 15 October.

Everything happened so quickly, unfortunately there wasn't time to say goodbye properly:

- we decided in March to move back
- unbelievably we sold our house in Villars Ste Croix by the end of May
- agreed date for moving out was 14 October
- we came to Bath for three days to find an apartment for 6 months, and, again unbelievably, found a 'perfect' house

As you can imagine, selling one house, buying another, packing up and moving involved a lot of mental and physical work. We'd been in the house in Villars Ste Croix for 31 years. so we'd accumulated more than a few items! That was the hardest part of moving - deciding what we could take and what had to be left behind. The Salvation Army did very well out of the move, and I got a loyalty card from the Dèchettri.

We are living in Bathford, a beautiful, small (1700 people) village 3 miles east of Bath. There's a really strong community spirit with numerous local activities, including a drama group! The village shop, just across the lane, and run by the community, is the focal point. We've been made to feel very welcome.

So, the start of a new life for me.
