#### How to get there:

- By car: There's parking in the street near there, and if you come early enough there should be space.
- Public transport: Bus 25, to the stop called Bois-de-Vaux, and then walk over.

#### What to bring:

- Stuff to grill and things to eat for yourself (sausages, steaks, chicken, and vegetables), and if you want, something to share (such as a salad or the like)
- A beach towel or a blanket to sit and picnic on, or a beach chair if you need it
- Frisbee, badminton, or the like
- Something to drink (if it gets warm, water is best, but if you're of the Anglosaxon confession or disposition, you can bring some liquid sunshine as well)
- A hat or a sunbrella, if you need a bit of protection from the sun

I will try to get there by 10 in the morning so we can reserve a grill and then get started. I will bring charcoal so you don't need to worry about any of that. I don't remember precisely where the big grill stations are, so it'll be along the beach somewhere, and I'll try to aim for the middle.
