# November clubnight - The Dakin Enigma & Differences Comments from the audience

#### THE DAKIN ENIGMA

Around 30 of us attended the Village Players Club Night on Thursday 26th November at the CPO to watch the short rehearsed play reading, written by Mike Scott and directed by Heather Gavin

A grieving widow, played superbly Gwen by Czajkowska, has written threatening letters to the police, two of whom visit her small. cramped flat London. She has criticised police for the their dishonesty and poor work concerning the investigation

of the death of her husband, a talented English composer.

The detectives, played by David Nunez and Saskia Faulk, listen to the slight eccentricity of Mrs Dakin reminiscing about her talented but militant late husband who apparently lacked for respect police. The detectives patiently listen to her sad but cherished memories and show kindly tolerance for Mrs Dakin. She wants peace of mind and the truth about her husband's murder and unexplained injuries only to

be told that all evidence has vanished from police records.

A moving play about love and loss and a widow seeking closure, who is choked with regret that no answers can be given. The audience could only have sympathy for Mrs Dakin and her predicament.







#### **DIFFERENCES**

The second half of the evening was dedicated to a lighthearted look at differences with poetry readings punctuated by "unusual" music, which would appeal to the connoisseur, to

which the audience were invited to sing along, albeit unsuccessfully.

The readers were the cast of the play reading joined by Colin Gamage, Heather Gavin and Mike Scott.

The cast created moments that rung true to the audience with a collection of poetry and prose carving through memories of childhood through to adulthood. Texts written by writers ranging from Spike Milligan to Ernest Hemingway on diverse subjects such as American presidents' failure to multi-task or children being flushed down the toilet!

These amusing poems together with the rather diverse and unexpected music provided us all with a very entertaining evening.

#### **SOLUTION TO CHRIS'S PUZZLE:**

Answer: 50g.

Rationale: If 99g of a 100g-potato is water, there is 1g of something else that does not change in the drying process. When the amount of water in the potato drops to 98% of the potato, this 1g of something else now makes up 2% of the potato, indicating that the potato must now weigh 50g.
