At the moment we do have a candidate for the post of Production Co-ordinator but do not have candidates for the posts of Chairman, Events Coordinator, Business Manager and Membership Secretary. So before, or latest at, the AGM we will be looking for volunteers to come forward to fill these positions. Brief descriptions of these posts are:



CHAIRMAN: Neutral head of Society; represents the Society and ensures its interests. Chairs committee meetings, AGMs and EGMs. Arbitrates in any disputes amongst members. Is 'front line' in any confrontations with other organisations.

PRODUCTION COORDINATOR: Responsible for the coordination of all public stage productions. Soliciting from members their suggestions for plays, distribution of copies of suitable works to the Committee. Advising and giving counsel to the director on the formation of the necessary production team.

EVENTS COORDINATOR: The position of Events Coordinator involves the organization of our monthly theatrical activities and has the responsibility of the smooth running of these events, cooperating with the VP member running the Clubnight, the CPO staff, ensuring the hall is set up and ready for our evenings activities and asking a member of the audience to provide a write-up for the VPI.

BUSINESS MANAGER: Responsible for forward planning, negotiation for hire of theatres, rooms for productions and events; liaison with appropriate authorities for services, purchase of tickets, front of house, payment of dues and performance rights. Good spoken and written French would be an asset.

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY: Takes control of the Village Players' email address. Responsible for sending out the VPI to all the members who receive it by email, and for sending out publicity to everyone on our mailing list. Receives messages from people visiting our website who want to know more about the club. Makes sure that everyone who wants to become a member knows how to do that and that everyone who performs in a Village Players production is a paid-up member. Manages the membership list and all the members' details.
